SITUATION 1

Anna is about to go online to chat with Jenny when a small pop-up window appears informing her that the anti-virus programme has expired. She really wants to go online to talk to Jenny.

What could happen if she chooses to ignore the message?

SITUATION 2

Anna gets an email from an unknown person. The subject is "Cool online games" and it contains an attachment. It sounds tempting.

What would you suggest her to do?

SITUATION 3

Alex has to write a short school essay about the myth of Europe. He types "Europe" and "myth" in a search engine. The first website seems to contain everything he needs: text and pictures.

SITUATION 4
